

Student Code of Conduct

All students attending any event sponsored by Glencoe Junior High Project (GJHP) are expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior and adhere to the following guidelines. If a student demonstrates behavior in conflict with this Code of Conduct, their parent/guardian will be contacted immediately to pick up their student. Additionally, the parent/guardian will be required to be on-site to supervise the student at future GJHP events attended.

- Students must adhere to the Central School "Expected Student Behavior" guidelines; conduct themselves in a manor reflective of the Central School values; and demonstrate respect for the school, their peers, and themselves at all times while attending GJHP events.
- Students are not allowed to bring outside food or beverages, not provided by GJHP, to any event, unless related to a personal dietary need and approved by a parent/guardian.
- Students attending an event must stay inside of the designated venue and may not leave the event until the stated end time, unless permission to leave early is provided by a parent or guardian. Parents are welcome to pick up students early for any reason, after checking-in with a designated chaperone.
- All food and beverages served at the event, must be consumed in the designated eating/drinking areas.
- If any student requires assistance, or has questions and/or concerns at any time during an event, they are strongly advised to seek assistance from a designated chaperone.

GJHP is a parent led, not-for-profit organization, serving middle school aged students (grades 5-8) residing in Glencoe IL. At all large group events, GJHP engages parent chaperones, estimating a ratio of 1 chaperone for every 15-20 students (depending upon the nature of the event).
